• Seen that the center is offering unique and comprehensive services.


This unit became a model for the Palestinian and donors; As example, MAP UK established similar unit in Rafidia governmental hospital in Nablus




Breast Cancer Unit

Breast unit at Beit-jala hospital:

- Full service at one spot
- This unit provides full service for breast cancer disease at one place, by multidisciplinary team, from imaging by radiologists with digital tomosynthesis 3D to reading results and US then Biopsies -If needed".





Goals of the Unit:


- Provide most accurate, clear results, and manage difficult cancer cases at full service spot.
- Save time, decrease x-ray exposure, reduce costs to the government, double check, fewer other tests, especially biopsies.

Referral to the unit

So referral to the unit is from different places:

- From primary Health Care screening service
- From the clinics in the hospital "Beit-Jala hospital"
- From private clinics outside hospital

Breast Cancer Status in Palestine

- Breast cancer is the most common cancer among Palestinian women. It's the second commonest cause of death
- Breast cancer accounts for 32% of all cancer among females
- Incidence Rate: 36 per 100,000 women (MOH 2021)
- In 2022 there were 540 new breast cancer cases registered in the West Bank and 394 in Gaza (Health Annual Report Palestine 2022 State of Palestine Ministry of Health)

Graph (29) Crude incidence and mortality rates of breast cancer per 100,000 female population, West Bank, 2012-2021











Graph (32) Percent distribution of female breast cancer by age groups, West Bank 2017-2021




Graph (36) Percentage distribution of breast cancer cases by stage at diagnosis and year, West Bank 2017-2021





- Universally, Incidence of breast cancer below 40 year is about 5%
- However, in our study in Bethlehem we have noticed increased incidence of young breast cancer represents to be 13%
- In United States, the median age at the time of breast cancer diagnosis is 62. in our study the median age is 52 years which means that Breast Cancer begins 10 years younger.

Family History Most women diagnosed with breast cancer don't have a women diagnosed with breast cancer have a first-degree

- family history of the disease. About 15 percent of female relative
- The lifetime risk is up to 4 times higher if a mother and sister are affected, and it is about 5 times greater in women who have two or more first-degree relatives with breast cancer.







- Hormonal receptors is necessary for the treatment and prognosis
- Hormonal receptors positive tumors are responsive to hormone therapy and tend to grow more slowly about 70-80% of breast cancer are ER/PR positive, in our study it represents 72%
- Hormonal receptors negative grow faster
- Her2 +ve tumors are more aggressive and have worse prognosis (higher recurrence rate and increased mortality worldwide accounts for 15%, in our study it represents 23%

As we see that the number of diagnosed cancer is serious and not

a small number.

The patient saves time and several trips to decide where to go and will encourage all patients to come because they will be comfort that they will find everything they need in

one place.

• My dream came true finally by opening my own private clinic that I worked hard to let it at a very high level.

• This is the first private Breast clinic in Bethlehem to be directed by a female doctor.




