


Inter-Municipal Cooperation in Croatia

CROATIA IN BRIEF: .



POLITICAL SYSTEM:

Parliamentary Republic

- POPULATION: 4,3 mil.
- CAPITAL: Zagreb (population: 779.145)
- GDP p/c 14.000\$
- LANGUAGE: Croatian
- RELIGION:

Catholics (86,3%), Muslims (1,5%), Orthodox (4,4%)

• EU MEMBERSHIP: 1.7.2013.





DID YOU KNOW?

- Invention of necktie (cravat) is attributed to Croatian mercenaries serving in regiment of King Louis XIII in 1630.
- Nikola Tesla, the inventor who invented the alternating current (electricity) was born in 10 July 1856 in Smiljan, Licko senjska County.
- Slavoljub Penkala, the inventor who invented solid-ink pen, lived most of his life in Croatia despite his Polish-Dutch origin.

TERRITORIAL DIVISION



20 Counties + City of Zagreb

Each county consists of towns and municipalities. In total:

- 127 towns
- 428 municipalities

Special status: City of Zagreb

Smallest & biggest municipality:

- Civljane 239 residents
- Viškovo 14,495 residents

Smallest & biggest town:

- Komiža 1,650 residents
- Split 167,121 resident

FEW ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON LOCAL GOVERMENT SYSTEM

- 30% of the population lives in municipalities
- average municipality 3,000 inhabitants
- average town 18,000 inhabitants
- each local unit has elected council and the mayor
- own sources of revenues
- areas of special State care (islands, mountain areas, war affected areas)

ENVIRONMENT FOR IMC

- Enabling but unsupportive legal framework
- In rare cases cooperation is mandatory (IMC is mostly informal, based on initiative of local units)
- Lack of financial incentives
- Lack of the culture of cooperation (culture of self-sufficiency)

COMMON AREAS OF IMC

- Promoting joint interests (LG associations)
- Communal Enterprises (waste collection and disposal, delivery of drinking water ...)
- Communal Police
- Kindergarten
- Public transport

RAREST AREAS OF IMC

- Administration
- Culture and Economics
- Social services
- Firefighting
- Development planning
- Education
- Health services

INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR IMC

- Joint Company or other legal entity
- Joint Administrative department
- Joint body
- Other (contract, agreement ...)

There are no specific IMC institutions in Croatia. For that reason established entities have no their own sources of income

HOW IT WORKS?

- IMC is either specifically indicated in the law or it's not
- Council decision
- Contract/Agreement (by executives, needs to solve all logistical details including management, financing ...)
- Implementation
- Monitoring & evaluation


EXAMPLES OF MANDATORY IMC

JOINT COMMUNAL COMPANY (If the system of communal infrastructure extends to the territory of several local governments ...)

COOPERATION ON ISLANDS (Waste collection – transport and disposal, public transport ...)

DRAFTING OF ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION
PROGRAMMES (Mandatory cooperation between regional and local units)

EXAMPLE OF GOOD PRACTICE



- Location: island of Hvar
- Joint institution for management of the archeological site (UNESCO Cultural Heritage)
- City of Stari Grad (2/3) and Municipality Jelsa (1/3)
- Managing body: 5 members (3 from local units 2 from ministries)
- Director is appointed jointly
- Financing: by founders and from the State budget



EXAMPLE OF GOOD PRACTICE



- Collection and communal waste disposal
- 1 town and 8 municipalities (%): Beli Manastir (75.07); Bilje (1); Čeminac (1); Darda (17.93); Draž (1); Jagodnjak (1); Kneževi Vinogradi (1); Petlovac (1); Popovac (1)
- 40,000 inhabitants, 1,200 km2, 28 employees
- Assembly: all founders are represented, meets once a year
- Supervisory Board: all founders are represented, meets 5-6 times a year
- Managing Body: director, 4 year mandate, management and legal representation of the company

INNOVATIVE APPROACH



- Office for international cooperation (4 municip.) in the form of association
- Development and implementation of joint projects
- Joint payment of overhead costs
- 4 employees
- In 2008 projects worth 7
 mil. €
