*An innovative service model for providing tailor-made employment services to young people (**18-35**) and employers*



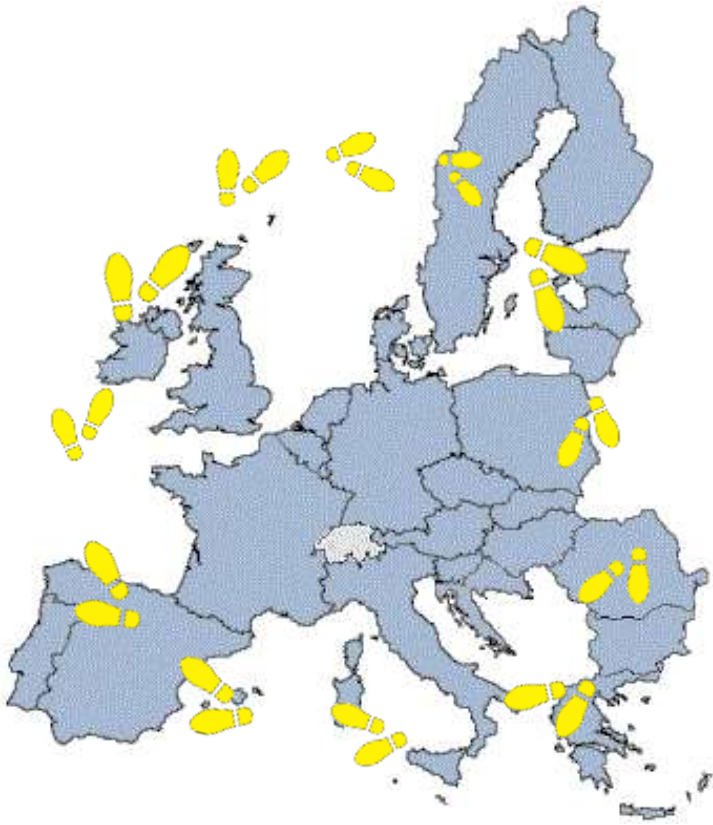

European Background

- ➔ Financed by EaSI (European Programme for Employment and Social Innovation)
- ➔ Launched with *Communication of 7 December 2016 on the European Solidarity Corps (COM (2016) 942 final)*
- ➔ The European Solidarity Corps brings together young people to build a more inclusive society, supporting vulnerable people and responding to societal challenges
- ➔ It offers an inspiring and empowering experience for young people who want to help, learn and develop

- Aged 18-30 years
- National of an EU MS
- Legally resident in an EU MS

EMPLOYER S

- Legally established in the EU28 MS, irrespective of the size or legal status of the company

Contribution to the costs incurred with Language Course	Actual declared costs – up to EUR 1.500
Contribution to the costs incurred with Recognition of Qualification	EUR 400 (flat rate)
Supplementary allowance for young people with special needs (Specific mobility needs)	Reimbursement of eligible declared costs – up to EUR 1.000 per trip
Subsistence allowance for recruited trainees	Complementary fee – up to EUR 600 / month (max 6 month)
