About the ENPI CBC Med Programme Focus on 2007-2013 period

- **13 countries**: Cyprus, Egypt, Greece, France, Israel, Italy, Jordan, Lebanon, Malta, Palestine, Portugal, Spain, Tunisia
- Budget: **€200 million**
- Key principles: partnership, co-ownership, common benefits
- Management of the Programme entrusted to the Autonomous Region of Sardinia (italy), supported by 2 Branch offices in Aqaba (Jordan) and Valencia (Spain)

About the ENPI CBC Med Programme Overview of results

- 3 calls for proposals: 1995 grant applications recived
- 95 funded projects 727 organizations involved
- Total value of funded projects: €204 million

- National consultations on the Policy Objectives based on the draft territorial analysis: ongoing ending 27th of October
- Task Force decision on the Programme objectives: first Week
 of December 2020
- National consultations on specific objectives and actions: end of 2020 - beginning 2021
- Adoption of the regulatory framework: **beginning 2021**
- Submission of the Programme document to the European Commission: **summer 2021**
